EURO 2024 FESTIVAL in the Host City Stuttgart: Public viewing and colorful program in the four Fan Zones / Urgent recommendation to use public transport

UEFA EURO 2024 in Stuttgart on June 19, 2024: Germany plays in Stuttgart, public viewing on Schlossplatz and much more

Stuttgart - The second match of UEFA EURO 2024 will take place in Stuttgart on June 19, 2024: The German national team led by national coach Julian Nagelsmann will play Hungary in its second match at the Stuttgart Arena. Kick-off is at 6 pm. The team is already on its way to the round of sixteen after its opening win against Scotland - which is why this match will attract particular attention: with a sold-out stadium, full public viewing and lots of fans on the streets before and after the game.

The authorities in Stuttgart have made preparations to maintain mobility as best they can. One thing is clear: fans, commuters and citizens will face a test of patience this Wednesday.

Mercedesstrasse will be fully closed early in the morning (from around 8 a.m.). This means that it will no longer be possible to travel to and from Bad Cannstatt via Mercedesstraße, Benzstraße, Daimlerstraße and Alte Untertürkheimer Straße. This will affect all traffic on the main roads to and from Bad Cannstatt. The city will have detours signposted, but it is advisable to drive well around the NeckarPark area.

The high volume of visitors will also lead to planned and certainly also spontaneous closures in the city center and neighboring districts between 1 and 6 pm. Two main traffic arteries, federal highways (Bundesstraße) 14 and 27, will be particularly affected.

In the early afternoon, the B14 Cannstatter Straße will be closed in both directions, Wolframstraße in the direction of the B14, Uferstraße in the direction of the city center, Neckartalstraße in the direction of the city center and König-Karl-Brücke in the direction of Bad Cannstatt. In addition, the B27 Friedrichstraße in the direction of Rotebühlplatz, Heilbronner Straße out of town to Türlenstraße and Schillerstraße in the direction of Arnulf-Klett-Platz will be closed.

It is therefore strongly recommended that you avoid driving on Wednesday and use buses, trains and bicycles instead.

FAN ZONE MARKTPLATZ

The Fan Zone Marktplatz is once again full of sporting events. With its soccer court and two gaming areas, it is the perfect meeting place for all those who like to be active themselves. Tournaments, fan matches and other sporting activities will take place at the Fan Zone Marktplatz, where visitors can also drop by for a spontaneous match! In addition, the mascot Albärt will prepare the fans for the game by getting them in the right mood with a little warm-up.

Program at the Fan Zone Marktplatz on June 19, 2024 in detail:

- 8:00 a.m. – 6 p.m.: "Fan.Tastic Females" exhibition on the 3rd and 4th floors of the town hall. The exhibition sheds light on soccer culture from the perspective of female fans.
- 1:30 p.m.: AI and Data Science in soccer. Host City Stuttgart ambassador Cacau and soccer data analysts give a data-based preview of the Germany-Hungary match in the multifunctional room.
- All day: Tournaments, fan matches and a variety of sports activities will be presented on the soccer court. Visitors can also drop by for a spontaneous match.
- All day: Play in the two gaming areas. In the outdoor gaming area, action tools such as a Teqball table and the SUTU Wall can be tried out. In the indoor gaming area there is a table football table and a football box. EA Sports FC can also be played. In the Creator Studio, pictures are created that are reminiscent of an unforgettable fan day in the Host City Stuttgart.
- Before the start of the game: warm-up with the mascot Albärt

Special eye-catchers: The oversized soccer player, the large façade painting and the Giant Trophy in the town hall (opening hours: 8:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.). There will also be a social wall on the market square where unique fan impressions can be seen, which will be published on social media using the hashtag #hostcitystuttgart. There will also be a fan make-up session in the Fan Zone Marktplatz.
