UEFA EURO 2024 in Stuttgart: the highlights on June 22, 2024 - with public viewing, acoustic music and much more

Stuttgart - After the top match between the Netherlands and France in Group D, the UEFA EURO 2024 FESTIVAL continues to entertain in the Host City Stuttgart. Three exciting matches are on the schedule for June 22, 2024: Georgia will face the Czech Republic in Hamburg, Turkey will take on Portugal in Dortmund and Cologne will host Belgium against Romania. The Host City Stuttgart will be broadcasting all matches live in the Fan Zone Schlossplatz - including a stadium-like atmosphere. Throughout the day, all four Fan Zones Schlossplatz, Marktplatz, Karlsplatz and Schillerplatz will once again offer an exciting supporting program - including the Ralph Widmann Duo, a variety of activities in the Fan Zone Marktplatz and plenty of gastronomic highlights.

Good to know: All four Fan Zones will be open from 12 noon to 12 midnight on match days during UEFA EURO 2024 (until 11 p.m. on non-match days). Admission is free on all days. The daily program of the EURO 2024 FESTIVAL Stuttgart on June 22, 2024:

FAN ZONE SCHLOSSPLATZ:

The Fan Zone Schlossplatz invites soccer fans to enjoy public viewing throughout the UEFA EURO 2024. All matches of the European Football Championship will be broadcast live on two large screens. In front of a unique city backdrop and together with fans from all over the world, a stadium-like atmosphere will be created. Fans on the Fan Zone Schlossplatz will get into the mood for today's EURO day from midday with DJs from SWR. There will also be various fan activities to have a great time until the first match kicks off fly by. A wide range of culinary delights will be on offer from 15 restaurants and cafés.

12:00 noon: Gates open
1:00 p.m.: SWR DJs and fan activities
3:00 p.m.: Live broadcast of the match Georgia – Czech Republic
6:00 p.m.: Live broadcast of the match Turkey - Portugal
9:00 p.m. Live broadcast of the match Belgium - Romania
12:00 midnight: End of event

Particularly eye-catching and recommended as a photo hotspot: The Rosenrondell (or rose traffic circle) on Königstrasse is planted in the shape of the EURO Cup.

Arrival at the Fan Zone Schlossplatz:

Generally, the following applies: A high number of visitors is expected in Stuttgart over the entire period until July 14, 2024. This will also affect traffic. In addition, there may be situational road closures on the main roads that cannot be planned in advance. These will occur on an ad hoc basis in addition to the existing closures in the city center.

The parking garages in the city center are not accessible. There are a few parking facilities outside the Cityring.

After the matches (regardless of the Host City Stuttgart venue), obstructions due to motorcades must be expected. This may result in temporary road closures, especially in the city center. Additional traffic obstructions are then expected.

It is therefore strongly recommended that you travel by public transport or bicycle.

The U6 light rail line runs every ten minutes from the airport to "Schlossplatz" station, with a journey time of 30 minutes. Alternatively, the S-Bahn lines S2 and S3 can be used to the main station. Travel time: 30 minutes.

From the main station, take the light rail lines U5, U6, U7, U12 and U15 to the "Schlossplatz" stop. The journey time is two minutes. The walk takes about ten minutes.

FAN ZONE MARKTPLATZ

The Fan Zone Marktplatz is once again becoming a sporting venue. With a soccer field and two game areas, the Fan Zone is the meeting place for those who like to be active.

Program at the Fan Zone Marktplatz on June 22, 2024 in detail:

- All day: Tournaments, fan matches and other sporting activities will take place on the soccer court. Fans can also drop by for a spontaneous match.
- All day: Playing in the gaming areas. In the outdoor gaming area, you can try out various equipment, such as a Teqball table and the SUTU ball wall. In the indoor gaming area there is a tabletop soccer table, a Bolzbox (or football box), and you can play EA Sports FC. In the Creator Studio, pictures can be created that provide reminders of an unforgettable fan day in the Host City Stuttgart.

Special eye-catcher : The oversized soccer player, the large façade painting and the Giant Trophy in the town hall (opening hours: 08:00-18:00). There is also a social wall on the Marktplatz where unique fan impressions can be seen, which will be published on social media using the hashtag #hostcitystuttgart.

FAN ZONE KARLSPLATZ

The program of the Fan Zone Karlsplatz revolves around culture and music. On June 22, 2024, the Ralph Widmann Duo, which plays acoustic music, will take to the stage. Equipped with a strong voice and a guitar, they will bring together a wide variety of musical styles from several decades on stage. Specially selected favorite songs are interpreted acoustically and sent on a new journey. Also worth a visit is the sustainability pavilion there, which provides an understanding of the many different areas of sustainability and how they can be implemented in everyday life, thus contributing to education for sustainable development. And if you need a short break, the Chill Out Area with its comfortable seating is the place to be.

The Safer Space is open every day until July 14, 2024.

- on match days from 1:30 p.m. to 1:00 a.m.
- on non-match days from 1:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.

In addition, the specially trained Awareness Team of Host City Stuttgart is clearly recognizable with bright blue, branded vests. Those affected can also contact the security service, the volunteers or the German Red Cross (Deutsche Rote Kreuz).
