

<u>EURO 2024 FESTIVAL in the Host City Stuttgart: Extraordinary emotions at the Fan Zone</u> Schlossplatz / Urgent recommendation to use public transport

UEFA EURO 2024 in Stuttgart on June 23, 2024: Match Day in the Host City Stuttgart, public viewing and documentary series VfB inTeam

Stuttgart – On June 23, 2024 at 9 p.m., Scotland will play Hungary in the Stuttgart Arena, while the German national team led by national coach Julian Nagelsmann will play Switzerland in Frankfurt at the same time. The public viewing in the Fan Zone Schlossplatz will be particularly emotional next Sunday. And this time the UEFA EURO 2024 FESTIVAL Stuttgart will start well before the kick-off of the live broadcast between Germany and Switzerland. At 3:15 p.m. there will be a very special highlight for all Stuttgart football fans: the final episode of the documentary series "VfB inTeam" will be shown on the two giant screens, which highlights VfB Stuttgart's extraordinary past season and at the end of which four VfB players were called up to the German EURO-squad. Admission is from 12 noon and free.

Urgent information on road traffic on June 23, 2024

The preliminary round of UEFA EURO 2024 is heading for the home straight next Sunday. 51,000 visitors are expected in the sold-out Stuttgart Arena. Many people will be out and about in the city center again. The Fan Zone Schlossplatz is also likely to be completely full, as 30,000 fans will watch the DFB team's parallel match against Switzerland at the public viewing. To avoid queues, it is advisable to arrive in good time. Kick-off for both games is at 9 p.m.


The traffic regulations for Sunday will be based on the concept that proved successful at the first two UEFA EURO matches in Stuttgart. Mercedesstraße will once again be fully closed from 8 a.m. After that, it will no longer be possible to drive to and from Bad Cannstatt via Mercedesstraße, Benzstraße, Daimlerstraße and Alte Untertürkheimer Straße. This will affect all traffic on the main roads to and from Bad Cannstatt. The city will have detour signposted. However, it is advisable to drive well around the NeckarPark area.

Due to the large number of fans walking around the city, of which many want to reach the arena on foot, closures are also planned in the city center and neighboring districts – but a little later than for the Germany match last Wednesday due to the late kick-off times.

This time, the B14 / Cannstatter Straße will again be closed in both directions, Wolframstraße in the direction of the B14, Uferstraße in the direction of the city center, Neckartalstraße in the direction of the city center and König-Karls-Brücke in the direction of Bad Cannstatt from 4 p.m. onwards.

The B27 / Friedrichstraße and the B27 / Theodor-Heuss-Straße will also be closed in both directions from 4 p.m. for the transfer of fans. Further closures are possible spontaneously as required. The City of Stuttgart therefore strongly recommends avoiding car journeys in the city center and in the Bad Cannstatt/NeckarPark area on Sunday and using buses, trains and bicycles instead.

Preview of the first match-free day on June 27, 2024

All four Fan Zones of the Host City Stuttgart will also be filled with an attractive program on the non-match days. A special highlight: the top-class concerts in the Fan Zone Schlossplatz. At 7 p.m., the Black Forest singer and songwriter Madeline Juno will come on stage, a musician who tells stories and emotions in a way that makes it easy for people to immerse themselves in these. Regardless of whether she is playing pop and loud songs with her full live band or acoustic versions with just her ukulele, Madeline Juno always captivates her audience.

Her Berlin colleague Philipp Dittberner, who conquered the charts with the hit "Wolke 4" and went on tour with his new album "Alles ist ein Augenblick" in May 2024, will take over the mic. Dittberner gets to the heart of barely tangible feelings in his songwriting, creating encounters for his fans in their everyday lives.

This summer evening will conclude with singer and songwriter Joris, who landed a platinum mega hit with his song "Herz über Kopf" and captivated viewers on "Sing meinen Song - Das Tauschkonzert" (VOX).

Program at the Fan Zone Markplatz on June 23, 2024 in detail:


- All day: Tournaments, fan matches and other sporting activities will take place on the soccer court. Fans can also drop by for a spontaneous match.



Safer Space in the Fan Zone Karlsplatz

A Safer Space in the form of an office container will be set up in the Fan Zone Karlsplatz during UEFA EURO 2024. Here, people affected by discriminatory behavior can find help and support from trained specialists.

The Safer Space is open every day until July 14, 2024.

- on match days from 1:30 p.m. to 1:00 a.m.
- on non-match days from 1:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.

In addition, the specially trained Awareness Team of Host City Stuttgart is clearly recognizable with bright blue, branded vests. Those affected can also contact the security service, the volunteers or the German Red Cross (Deutsche Rote Kreuz).

FAN ZONE SCHILLERPLATZ

A table football tournament with the legendary table soccer world champion Chris Marks will take place at the Stadtwerke Stuttgart stand in the Fan Zone Schillerplatz on June 23. But soccer fans will also find culinary specialties here, because anyone cheering on the UEFA EURO 2024 teams and following the matches will need a snack in between. The food stands offer something for every taste. In addition to refreshing drinks, there is a wide range of vegetarian and vegan dishes and visitors can also try typical Swabian specialties and many other delicacies from the region.


