UEFA EURO 2024 in Stuttgart: The Highlights on June 27, 2024 – with national acts, the clown duo Strange Comedy and much more

Stuttgart – The group stage of UEFA EURO 2024 will be over soon and the round of 16 is just around the corner. But before the ball starts rolling again, the host city of Stuttgart offers music fans and event enthusiasts a variety of highlights. On June 27, 2024, concerts by artists such as Madeline Juno, Phillip Dittberner and Joris will create a great atmosphere in the Fan Zone Schlossplatz. Throughout the day, all four Fan Zones – Schlossplatz, Marktplatz, Karlsplatz and Schillerplatz – will once again offer an attractive supporting program, including the clown duo Strange Comedy, a variety of activities in the Fan Zone Marktplatz, and many culinary highlights.

Good to know: The Fan Zone Schlossplatz opens at 4 pm. The Fan Zones Karlsplatz, Schillerplatz and Marktplatz start their program at 12 noon. Admission to all Fan Zones – including the concerts in the Fan Zone Schlossplatz – is free of charge. The daily program of the EURO 2024 FESTIVAL Stuttgart on June 27, 2024:

FAN ZONE SCHLOSSPLATZ:

While the Fan Zone Schlossplatz invites football fans to public viewing during UEFA EURO 2024, music fans can now get their money's worth as well. Visitors will be able to enjoy a unique concert experience free of charge in front of a unique city backdrop and together with major national acts.

First of all, the SWR DJ will provide the best atmosphere from 5:30 p.m., before the Black Forest singer and songwriter Madeline Juno performs her greatest hits on stage. Her Berlin musician colleague Philipp Dittberner, who conquered the charts with his hit "Wolke 4", will then take over. Singer and songwriter JORIS ("Herz über Kopf") will close this unique summer evening. Admission is free of charge. A wide range of culinary delights will be provided by 15 gastronomy businesses.

Whether it's pop and loud songs with her full live band or acoustic versions with just her ukulele, Madeline Juno manages to captivate her audience while being honest and personal. She tells stories and emotions in a way that makes it easy to get lost in them. The artist takes nearly one million monthly listeners on an uncompromisingly honest journey through fear and doubt to courage and strength.

8:00 p.m.: Philipp Dittberner

Philipp Dittberner gets to the heart of barely tangible feelings in his songwriting and meets his fans in their everyday lives. Well-known hits like "Wolke 4" (2015, four times gold) show how timeless Dittberner writes German music history. His third album "Alles ist ein Augenblick", released in March this year, reflects love and friendship with emotional depth. It is not only his voice that inspires the masses. The singer-songwriter has been accompanying himself on the guitar since the age of twelve.

9:30 p.m.: Joris

The singer and songwriter Joris, who landed a platinum megahit with his song "Herz über Kopf" and captivated TV viewers on "Sing meinen Song - Das Tauschkonzert" (VOX), will close this summer evening. The 31-year-old singer-songwriter has always used the cycle of coming and going as a vital, creative engine for constant change and development. With his latest album " Willkommen Goodbye" he conveys a new form of relaxation, a more direct, freer approach to himself and a world in constant flux.

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How to get to the Fan Zone Schlossplatz:

In general: For the entire UEFA EURO 2024 period until July 14, 2024, Stuttgart is expected to be very busy. This will also affect traffic. In addition, there may be occasional road closures on the main roads that cannot be planned in advance. These will occur ad hoc in addition to the already existing closures in the central city center.

The car parks in the city center are not accessible. A few parking facilities are available outside the city ring.

After the matches (regardless of the location, Host City Stuttgart), car parades are likely to cause disruption. This may lead to temporary road closures, especially in the city center. Additional traffic disruptions are expected.

It is therefore strongly recommended to travel by public transport or bicycle.

From the airport, the U6 underground line runs every ten minutes to the Schlossplatz station, with a journey time of 30 minutes. Alternatively, S-Bahn lines S2 and S3 can be taken to the main railway station. Journey time: 30 minutes.

From the main railway station, the underground lines U5, U6, U7, U12 and U15 take you to Schlossplatz. The journey takes two minutes. The walk from there to the Fan Zone Schlossplatz takes about ten minutes.

FAN ZONE MARKTPLATZ

Despite the fact that the day is free of matches, the Fan Zone Marktplatz is once again a sports venue. If you like kicking the ball around or playing games, this is the place to be. There will be tournaments, fan matches and other sporting activities on the football pitch. Fans can also drop by for a spontaneous match. You can play as much as you like in the two gaming areas at Fan Zone Marktplatz.

Program at the Fan Zone Markplatz on June 27, 2024 in detail:

- All day: There will be tournaments, fan matches and other sporting activities on the soccer court. Fans can also drop by for a spontaneous match.
- All day: Games in the gaming areas. In the Outdoor Gaming area, you can try out action tools such as a Teqball plate and the SUTU wall. In the Indoor Gaming area there is a table football, a Bolzbox (football box) and EA Sports FC can be played. In the Creator Studio, images will be created to commemorate an unforgettable fan day in the Host City Stuttgart.

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Special eye-catcher : The oversized footballer, the large mural and the giant trophy in the town hall (opening hours: 08:00 a.m. -06:00 p.m.). There is also a social wall on the Fan Zone Marktplatz, where unique fan impressions are shown that can be posted on social media using the hashtag #hostcitystuttgart.

Getting to the Fan Zone Marktplatz

The walk from the "Stadtmitte" S- and U-Bahn underground station or from the main station to the Fan Zone takes approximately 10 minutes.

FAN ZONE KARLSPLATZ

The program of the Karlsplatz Fan Zone revolves around culture and music. On June 27, 2024, visitors can get active themselves at Yoga with Emma and then admire stilt walkers performing their skills. Starting at 4 p.m., clown duo Strange Comedy takes over the stage with their crazy illusions and acrobatic acts. Shelly Mia Kastner and Jason McPherson play two hapless vaudevillians trapped in a world where their show requisites have taken on a life of their own. Muppet-style costumes become uncontrollable, magic tricks go horribly wrong, and unforeseen situations arise as the two clowns try to survive in this cartoonish world of disasters. Strange Comedy is best known for its crazy illusions, surprising acrobatics, and hilarious and endearing clowning.

Also worth a visit is the Sustainability Pavilion, which provides information on the many areas of sustainability and how to implement them in everyday life, thus contributing to education for sustainable development. And if you need a break, the Chill Out Area with its comfortable seating is just the perfect place for you.

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Safer Space at the Fan Zone Karlsplatz

A Safer Space in the form of an office container will be set up on the Fan Zone Karlsplatz during UEFA EURO 2024. Here, those affected by discriminatory behavior will find help and support from trained staff.

The Safer Space will be open every day until July 14, 2024.

- on match days from 01:30 p.m. to 01:00 a.m.
- on non-match days from 01:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.

The specially trained awareness team from the Host City Stuttgart will be recognisable by their bright blue, branded vests.
