Stuttgart – Before the semi-finals kick off on July 9, the Host City Stuttgart invites you to celebrate together again on Monday, July 8. Stuttgart is not letting the Monday blues get in the way of a good mood for everyone with its after work event in the Fan Zone Schlossplatz. DJane Alegra Cole will provide the musical backdrop. All catering establishments in the Fan Zone Schlossplatz will be offering special drinks in a lounge atmosphere for the evening. The other three Fan Zones, Marktplatz, Karlsplatz and Schillerplatz, will also once again offer a sporting and musical program - including DJ Division, Pari Ciel, Little Acoustic Jukebox and Fan Matches.

Good to know: The Fan Zone Schlossplatz opens at 4 p.m. on July 8. The Fan Zones Karlsplatz, Schillerplatz and Marktplatz start their program at 12 noon. Admission to all Fan Zones is free of charge. Program on the Fan Zone Schlossplatz on July 8 in detail:

4 p.m.: Gates open

5 p.m.: DJane Alegra Cole

Stuttgart DJane Alegra Cole stands for elegance, glamor and cool sound. She mixes live at every event and works without a laptop. In March 2023, her track "Voyage Voyage" reached number 1 in the Swiss dance charts. This makes Alegra Cole one of only a handful of DJanes worldwide with a number 1 hit. She enchants her audience with her relaxed sounds and spontaneity.

11 p.m.: End of event

A special eye-catcher and recommended photo: The Rosenrondell on Königstraße is decorated with the shape of the EURO trophy.

How to get to the Fan Zone Schlossplatz:

In general: For the entire UEFA EURO 2024 period until July 14, 2024, Stuttgart is expected to be very busy. This will also affect traffic. In addition, there may be occasional road closures on the main roads that cannot be planned in advance. These will occur ad hoc in addition to the already existing closures in the central city center.

The car parks in the city center are not accessible. A few parking facilities are available outside the city ring.

After the matches (regardless of the location, Host City Stuttgart), car parades are likely to cause disruption. This may lead to temporary road closures, especially in the city center. Additional traffic disruptions are expected.

It is therefore strongly recommended to travel by public transport or bicycle.

From the airport, the U6 underground line runs every ten minutes to the Schlossplatz station, with a journey time of 30 minutes. Alternatively, S-Bahn lines S2 and S3 can be taken to the main railway station. Journey time: 30 minutes.

From the main railway station, the underground lines U5, U6, U7, U12 and U15 take you to Schlossplatz. The journey takes two minutes. The walk from there to the Fan Zone Schlossplatz takes about ten minutes.

FAN ZONE MARKTPLATZ

Despite the non-match day, the Fan Zone Marktplatz is once again a sporting venue. If you like kicking the ball around yourself or love gaming, this is the place to be. Tournaments, fan matches and other sporting activities take place on the football court. Fans can also drop by for a spontaneous match. There are also two gaming areas where fans have plenty of options to play various games all day.

Program on the Fan Zone Markplatz on July 8 in detail:

- **All day:** Play in the two gaming areas. In the outdoor gaming area, action tools such as a Teqball table and the SUTU Wall can be tried out. In the indoor gaming area, there is a table football table and a Bolzbox (football box). EA Sports FC can also be played. In the Creator Studio, pictures are created that are reminiscent of an unforgettable fan day in the Host City Stuttgart.

Special eye-catchers: The oversized soccer player, the large facade painting and the Giant Trophy in the town hall (opening hours: 8:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.). There will also be a social wall on the Fan Zone Marktplatz where unique fan impressions can be seen, which will be published on social media using the hashtag #hostcitystuttgart. Furthermore, there will be a fan make-up session in the Fan Zone Marktplatz.

Getting to the Fan Zone Marktplatz

The walk from the "Stadtmitte" S-Bahn and U-Bahn stations or from the main railway station to the Fan Zone takes about 10 minutes.

FAN ZONE KARLSPLATZ

The program of the Fan Zone Karlsplatz revolves around culture and music. On July 8, visitors can look forward to three musical highlights: Pari Ciel will start off by delighting the Stuttgart audience. With their swing & pop à la française, for example "Ni oui ni non", "Les Passants", French versions of Amy Winehouse, or English-language titles, a good mood is guaranteed. At Little Acoustic Jukebox, the audience chooses the songs themselves. Everyone can add their favorite songs to the iPad's setlist, which are then played for everyone according to the motto: "First come, first served". DJ Division, who has been active as a DJ and organizer since 2002 and is now one of the big names on the Stuttgart DJ scene, takes over. He combines hip hop, R&B, dancehall, soul and electronic influences with a keen sense of timing, creating the perfect sound for every moment.

The Safer Space is open every day until July 14, 2024.

- on match days from 1:30 p.m. to 1:00 a.m.
- on non-match days from 1:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.

In addition, the specially trained Awareness Team of the Host City Stuttgart is clearly recognizable with bright blue, branded vests. Those affected can also contact the security service, the volunteers or the German Red Cross (Deutsche Rote Kreuz).
