EURO 2024 FESTIVAL in the Host City Stuttgart: Top entertainment in the four Fan Zones even on non-match days

UEFA EURO 2024 in Stuttgart: The highlights on July 12, 2024 - silent disco, concerts, football tournaments and much more

Stuttgart - On Friday, July 12, the Host City Stuttgart will transform the Fan Zone Schlossplatz into a huge party place - without any audible noise from the loudspeakers. At the "Silent Disco", DJs from SWR1, SWR3 and SWR4 will play their sounds to the audience - all at the same time. Visitors decide for themselves via headphones which music they want to dance and party to. As always, admission is free.

Good to know: The Fan Zone Schlossplatz opens at 4 p.m. on July 12. The Fan Zones Karlsplatz, Schillerplatz and Marktplatz start their program at 12 noon. The daily program of the EURO 2024 FESTIVAL Stuttgart on July 12, 2024:

FAN ZONE SCHLOSSPLATZ:

Before the UEFA EURO 2024 final on July 14 attracts football fans to the public viewing once again, the Fan Zone Schlossplatz will host a party on Friday, July 12. True to the motto "One party, two worlds, three times more music", every music enthusiast will have lots of fun. The "Silent Disco" party trend allows revelers to decide for themselves which music they want to dance to using special headphones. The range of music is diverse: from pop, rock and pop classics to house, there is a free choice for your personal party. The headphones ensure that there is no background noise, so you can have a quiet conversation without them. The headphones for the "Silent Disco" will be issued on site for a deposit of 20 euros. Admission to the Fan Zone Schlossplatz and the "Silent Disco" is free of charge. A SWR DJ will get visitors in the mood for the evening at 6 p.m..

Getting to the Fan Zone Schlossplatz:

Generally, the following applies: Significant visitor numbers are expected in Stuttgart over the entire period until July 14, 2024. This will also affect traffic. In addition, there may be road closures on the main roads due to certain situations, which cannot be planned in advance. These will occur on an ad hoc basis in addition to the existing closures in the city center. The parking garages in the city center will not be accessible. There are a few parking spaces available outside the "Cityring".

After the matches (regardless of the Host City Stuttgart location), obstructions due to motorcades must be expected. This may result in temporary road closures, especially in the city center. Additional traffic obstructions are then expected. It is therefore strongly recommended that you travel by public transport or bicycle.

The U6 subway line runs every ten minutes from the airport to the "Schlossplatz" station, the journey takes 30 minutes. Alternatively, you can take the S2 and S3 commuter rail lines to the main station. Travel time: 30 minutes.

The U5, U6, U7, U12 and U15 subway lines run from the main station to the "Schlossplatz" stop. The journey time is two minutes. The walk takes about ten minutes.

FAN ZONE MARKTPLATZ

The Fan Zone Marktplatz will once again be the place to be for those who like to get active themselves on July 12. If you like playing football or gaming, this is perfect for you. Tournaments, fan matches and other sporting activities will take place on the Soccer Court. Fans can also drop by for a spontaneous match. There are also two gaming areas where you can play for all you're worth. On July 12, the wfv Class Kicks will take place. Primary school pupils compete against each other in tournament mode with youth referees. Afterwards, the Württemberg Football Association (wfv) will be offering a bambini and children's football demo training session. A children's football school will also be on site.

Program at the Fan Zone Marktplatz on July 12, 2024 in detail:

- **9:00 a.m-02:00 p.m.:** wfv Class Kicks
- **4:30 p.m.:** Bambini and children's football demo training of the WFV
- **All day:** Play in the two gaming areas. In the outdoor gaming area, action tools such as a Teqball table and the SUTU Wall can be tried out. In the indoor gaming area, there is a table football table and a Bolzbox (football box). EA Sports FC can also be played. In the Creator Studio, pictures are created that are reminiscent of an unforgettable fan day in the Host City Stuttgart.

Special eye-catchers: The oversized soccer player, the large facade painting and the Giant Trophy in the town hall (opening hours: 8:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.). There will also be a social wall on the Fan Zone Marktplatz where unique fan impressions can be seen, which will be published on social media using the hashtag #hostcitystuttgart.

Getting to the Fan Zone Marktplatz

The walk from the "Stadtmitte" S-Bahn and U-Bahn stations or from the main railway station to the Fan Zone takes about 10 minutes.

FAN ZONE KARLSPLATZ

The Fan Zone Karlsplatz program focuses on culture and music. On July 12, visitors can once again look forward to a varied stage program. The musical evening begins with Mr. Jones, who brings back the 80s and 90s with his distinctive, raspy voice, before Ben Reichert takes over the stage. His repertoire consists of pop/rock covers from the last 60 years and his own songs.

Also worth a visit is the sustainability pavilion at Fan Zone Karlsplatz, which explains the various areas of sustainability and how they can be implemented in everyday life, thus contributing to education for sustainable development. And if you need a little break, the chill-out area with its comfortable seating is the place to be.

The Safer Space is open every day until July 14, 2024.

- on match days from 1:30 p.m. to 1:00 a.m.
- on non-match days from 1:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.

In addition, the specially trained Awareness Team of the Host City Stuttgart is clearly recognizable with bright blue, branded vests. Those affected can also contact the security service, the volunteers or the German Red Cross (Deutsches Rotes Kreuz).
